

**>> What do I do as a Summer Food Program volunteer?**

Volunteers will be responsible for transporting fully cooked meals (that have been packaged and put into coolers for temperature regulation) to two "porch site" locations within Lewis County, either in the southern or western part of the county. Meals are free for anyone 18 years and under. The time commitment is 2 - 2.5 hours total. Volunteers are responsible for transporting the meals in their personal vehicles. You will also take books that can be given away for free to anyone who takes a meal.

Background check is required, which is paid for by the Lewis County Board of Education. **>> On your volunteer day(s)...**

Please arrive to the meal pickup location by NO LATER THAN 10:30am on your volunteer day. The time commitment is 2 - 2.5 hours total. (Meal pickup location will be Peterson Central Elementary School cafeteria from June 21 - July 21 and will be Robert L Bland Middle School cafeteria from July 24 - August 4). Specific directions to these locations will be provided.

When you arrive, the cooks will have meals cooked, packaged, and packed into coolers with the goal of leaving the pickup location by 10:45am.

You will be instructed by the cooks prior to leaving the school on what items should be provided for each meal and appropriate temperatures for each food item. You will be provided necessary paperwork to record temperatures, meals served, etc.

After you deliver meals, the coolers, paperwork, etc. must be returned to the pickup location.

**>> 2017 volunteer routes**

Volunteers will choose one of two routes - southern or western Lewis County.

Southern Lewis County: Stop 1 is Rana Estates Trailer Court. Stop 2 is Ireland Community Building. Specific driving directions will be provided.

Western Lewis County: Stop 1 is the former Alum Bridge School. Stop 2 is the Pricetown Fire Department. Specific driving directions will be provided.
