RE: Notification of locations and availability of Asbestos Management Plans

DATE:

On October 22, 1986, President Reagan signed into law the Hazard Emergency Response Act (**AHERA**). It required the Environmental Protection Agency (**EPA**) to issue regulations requiring all private and public elementary and secondary schools to be inspected for Asbestos. To take action in the event that any containing material was determined to be a possible health hazard and to develop a management plan for each school which would be publicly available and which would contain detailed results of the inspection and records of any actions taken by the school with respect to Asbestos.

On October 30, 1987, the EPA issued final regulations as required by law. These rules are widely known as the **1987 ASBESTOS IN SCHOOLS RULE, OR THE AHERA REGULATIONS**.

This notice is to inform you that in compliance with regulation 40 CFR Part 763.84 9 (c) a copy of **THE ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN for all schools and other locations are available for inspection**. To inspect any plan please contact the principal or me. Copies are available at all schools or board office.

Also, a regular six-month periodic surveillance of Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM) will be conducted during the Fall and Spring. Further, if any Asbestos response action (e.g. removal, repair, enclosure, encapsulation, or operations and maintenance) takes place in any school or other locations, notices will be posted.
