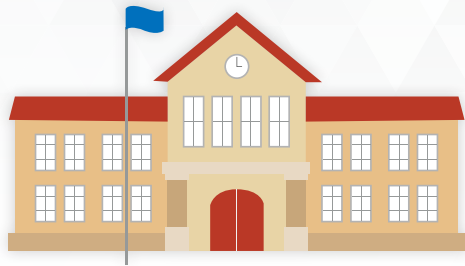

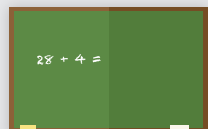
24-Hour On-Call Provider

We work with each school to allow students and faculty access to the medical care they need. Students and staff are able to receive routine screenings, physicals and immunizations in addition to having constant and reliable on-site care.

SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS:

- Provide preventative and primary healthcare right in the schools.
- Allow access to a wide variety of services for both physical and mental health conditions.
- Are not a replacement for the school nurse but can become the student's home for primary and preventative care.
