Lewis County Schools Provides Meals to Children During the Summer

The Lewis County Board of Education announces their sponsorship of the federally funded Summer Food Service Program.

When the school year ends, nutritional meals will be provided to any child 18 years of age or younger through the federal child nutrition program sponsored by the Lewis County Board of Education.

Breakfast and Lunch are open to all children, ages 18 years and under, who would like to participate.

Meals will be available to pick up at the following sites on **Monday** and **Thursday** each week. On Monday each child will receive a multiday pack containing three breakfasts and three lunches. On Thursdays each child will receive a multiday pack containing two breakfasts and two lunches.
