

Mandatory Reporting in West Virginia

I have reasonable cause to suspect that a child is neglected or abused or may have been sexually abused or sexually assaulted, or I have observed a child being subjected to conditions likely to result in abuse or neglect.



Report the circumstances to the WV Department of Health and Human Resources immediately, and within no more than 24 hours: 1-800-352-6513.



Report the circumstances to the principal or other person in charge of the entity or organization providing services to the school.



Do you suspect that the child has been subject to sexual abuse, sexual assault, or serious physical abuse?

No additional reporting is necessary.

Report the circumstances to the West Virginia State Police (304-746-2100) and local law enforcement immediately and within no more than 24 hours.

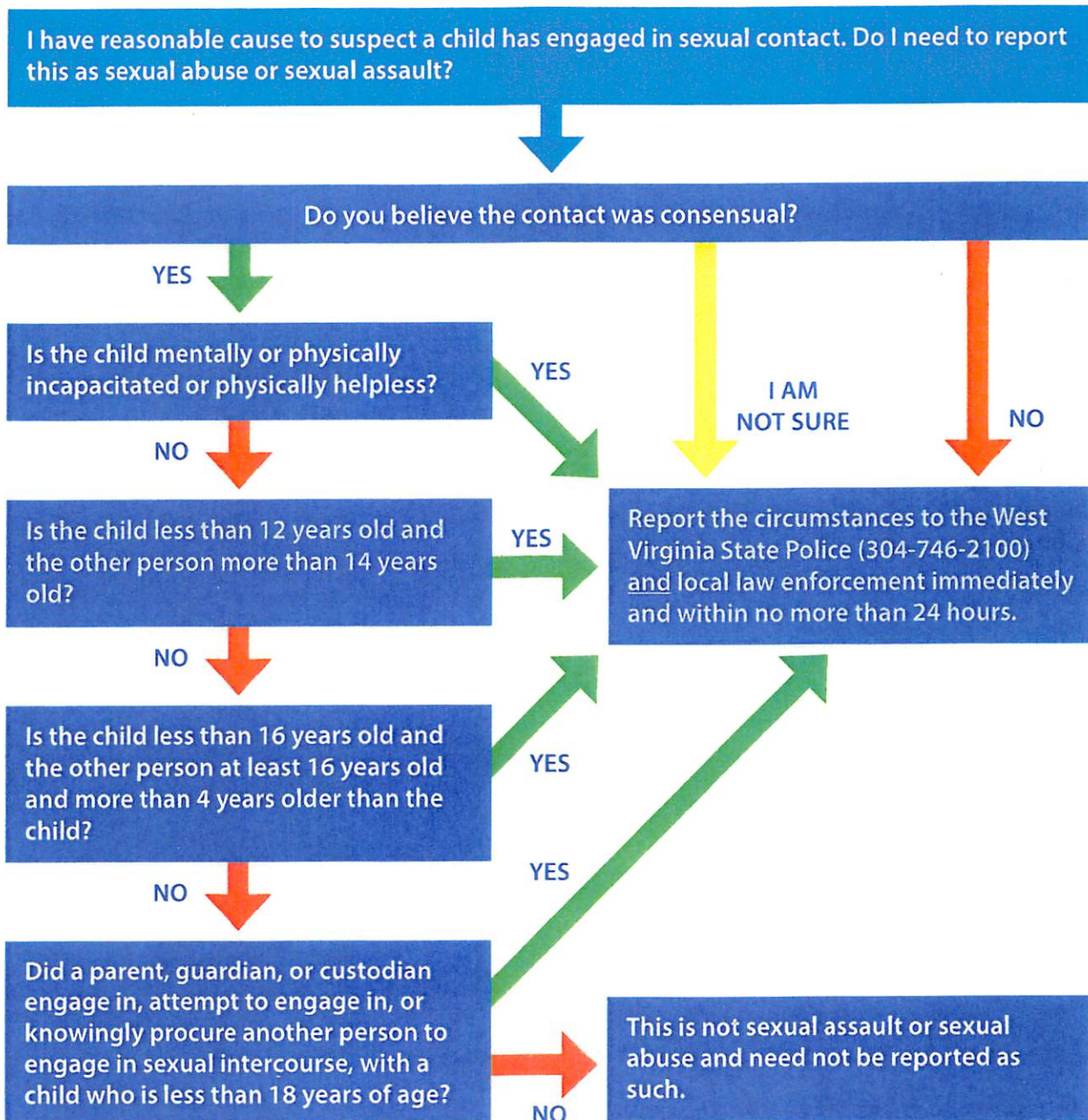
